Online Safety Workshop For Parents

The free workshop will give parents the skills and knowledge to understand the internet and technology as children do—from online games and cyber bullying, to setting up privacy settings and controls.



Administering medicine

Can we please remind parents that Medicines will only be administered that have been prescribed by a doctor or some other authorised person and where it would be detrimental to a child's health if the medicine were not administered during the day. Non-prescription medicines will not be administered by staff but parents/carers can make arrangements at lunch time to administer the medication to their child. Asthma inhalers, prescribed Piriton etc. are taken by the children when required, under supervision and doses/times recorded. Children taking antibiotics on a 3 times a day prescription should not require a dose to be administered in school. Children on a 4 times a day dose will, however we would question whether the child is actually well enough to be in school on such a high dose. Can we remind parents that our policy states:

"Administration of medicines by any member of the school personnel is undertaken purely on a voluntary basis and individual decisions will be respected."

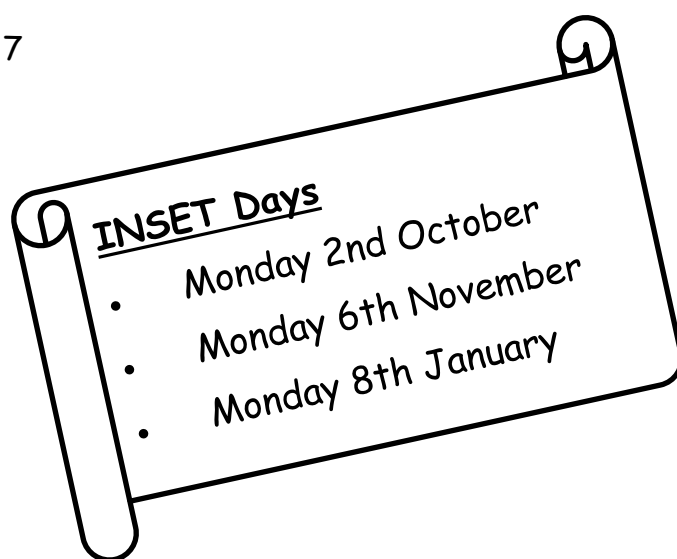
