Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to another school year at Llanhari Primary School. We hope that you all had a good summer break and that the children are happily settling back into school and the daily routines.

Our topic this term is 'Adventurers and Explorers'. This is a fabulous topic as it will allow us to not only learn about our local area, but also Wales and the wider world including famous explorers. We have undertaken pupil voice sessions, which have helped us to shape our curriculum this term.

Reminders:

- PE will be on Fridays. Children are to wear their school uniform on these days and bring their PE kits to school to get changed into. For PE, we encourage the children to wear black shorts/jogging bottoms/leggings, a plain white t-shirt, and trainers. No jewellery is to be worn.
- Children are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school each day, we have water facilities to refill drinks bottles if needed.
- We are promoting the importance of reading for pleasure. Please can you support us by regularly listening to your child read at home and signing their reading record. We ask that the children try to read little and often. At this age the children will benefit from reading a variety of materials at home, not just their school reading books. Materials such as newspapers, online reports, comics and recipe books are all good examples of suitable reading materials. Please can you ensure that the children bring their reading books and diary's back into school each day.
- HWB log-ons. The children will spend the next few days familiarising themselves again with our HWB platform. Their log on details will be sent home as a reminder, for them to access the platform from home too. The children are all signed up to Google Classroom, which is a platform accessed through HWB and is where homework tasks will be uploaded.
- Please can all uniform be labelled clearly with your child's name, as uniform gets misplaced regularly, labelled clothes make it easier to reunite. We are looking forward to an exciting year ahead! If you have any queries or questions, please don't hesitate to get in touch
