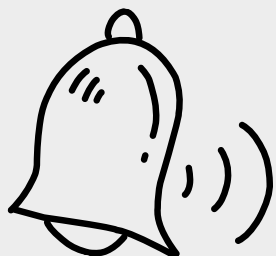

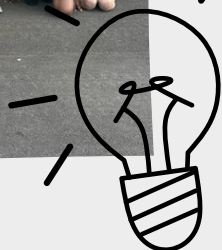
IMPORTANT INFORMATION
